The Helen Betty Osborne Memorial Foundation was established by an Act of the 2nd Session of the 37th Legislature of Manitoba, December 2000 under the auspices of the Attorney General, the Honourable Gord Mackintosh. The Act also acknowledges Helen Betty Osborne's dream of becoming a teacher before her premature death in 1971.

The Helen Betty Osborne Memorial Foundation, created in her memory as a fitting tribute to her life, provides financial assistance to Aboriginal youth enrolled in post-secondary studies in Manitoba.

Whether these young people dream of becoming a teacher or a doctor or prefer to study a trade, the Helen Betty Osborne Memorial Foundation helps them achieve their individual potential through an annual financial award. The amount can range from \$1,500 to \$5,000.



Since December 2000, the Helen Betty Osborne Memorial Foundation has awarded a total of \$95,000 to Aboriginal students in Manitoba. These awards helped pay for tuition and books but more importantly, brought each student a step closer to realizing their dreams.

The Helen Betty Osborne Memorial Foundation continually seeks to increase the number of annual financial awards through fundraising activities and donations but we need your support to make these educational dreams become a reality.
